

Needs Assessment:

- Star will meet with Cathy from One Health Insights this week and discuss the status of the needs assessment survey.
- Members of the group have contacts at multiple cancer centers, with primary care and pain management providers, and with social workers.
 - Kelly has contact with the Sweetwater Cancer Center, St. Johns in Jackson
 - Cindy has contact with centers in Cody, Powell, Lander, Lovell, Worland, and Thermopolis
 - Edith (non-member) has contact with Cheyenne Regional and the center in Laramie
 - Leigh will help with dissemination in Gillette, Sheridan
 - Abi has contact with centers and social workers in Casper, Laramie, and Cheyenne
 - Haley has contact with centers in Casper and Douglas
- Once the survey is completed, we will meet again to discuss a dissemination plan.

Resources Available (Resource List):

- Abi, WFCC director, has a running resource list on their organization's website of resources available across the state. Abi has the list organized by county and cancer type.
- Rather than duplicating the list, we may opt to leave the list hosted on the WFCC website. Other locations and websites can link to the WFCC page.
- We can either cross-reference the lists from organizations like Wyoming 211 and the Olivia Caldwell Foundation or simply list those organizations on the website.

Increase Training & Education:

- Discussed the benefit of organizing meetings between cancer centers. This is a far-off goal, and the needs assessment may help identify where training topics could come from.
- This could be an area to add to the resource list as well. Leigh expressed that it is worthwhile to know what the other centers have to offer as well, helping patients stay local as much as possible.
