Meeting Notes:

The small group present at the spring WYCC meeting discussed cancer plan strategies to work on now that coordination for the survivor needs assessment is complete. Most of the discussion centered on provider education, specifically primary care providers and cancer centers. While the ultimate goal is ensuring primary care providers are providing and working on survivorship care plans with their patients, that may not be practical at this time. The group discussed reaching out to local cancer centers to determine their current warm-handoff practices. Shawna noted that some oncology providers stop prescribing medications (such as routine blood pressure meds), but they don't give their patients the next steps to stay retained in care. Starting with



cancer centers allows the group to both start small and ensure they are all offering the same level of care coordination to all WY cancer survivors. The small group will look at existing recommendations and resources for survivor care/care plans, and they will present their findings at the next whole workgroup meeting. The group will use those findings and the OHI survivor needs assessment data to determine what exactly we'd like to know as we start discussing WY cancer centers current practices.



Strategy 2: Provider Education

Action plan:

- Research current linkage to care best practices (the warm handoff from oncology back to primary care). The workgroup members present 03/01 will review available survivorship care plans and guidelines from entities such as the American Cancer Society, George Washington Cancer Institute, etc., and share them in the WYCC Survivorship Workgroup Google Drive ([link](#)).
 - By next WYCC survivorship workgroup meeting (within 3-4 weeks).
- OHI will finalize the results of the survivor needs assessment and send that to Star for the survivorship workgroup to review.
 - By next WYCC survivorship workgroup meeting (within 3-4 weeks).
- Haley McKee will share a Doodle poll to schedule the next WYCC survivorship workgroup meeting.
 - Schedule the meeting within 3-4 weeks.
- The survivorship workgroup will work together utilizing currently available resources and OHI survey results to create a set of questions to assess current cancer center linkage to care/discharge practices.
 - Assess what exactly we want to know about warm handoff practices.
 - Compile a universal set of questions to ask every cancer center.
 - By end of next WYCC survivorship workgroup meeting.
- The survivorship workgroup will assess individuals' capacity to collaborate with WY cancer centers on their current discharge/linkage to care practices.



- Haley McKee to create an assessment for how workgroup members wish to participate in the group, their level of capacity for involvement, and requesting volunteers to achieve certain action items.
- Volunteers to connect with one to two cancer centers and collect their current policies, discharge documents, and record responses to the questions developed by the workgroup.
- Within the next 5-6 months.
