 - o Data used to drive workgroup projects last year.

Mediport Access

- Initial strategy was to send out some vans and nurses from Denver to Wyoming teach local people how to access mediports.
 - o Last discussion found that is not the best long-term solution
 - o Current plan of action is to partner as best as possible with adult cancer centers, because we have some models for doing that, particularly in Casper and Gillette where our kids can go up there and get access.
 - o Iowa doing similar work, will share there methods.
- Palliative Care & Hospice care
 - o Working with Casper and Denver for distribution of care.
 - o Repspite care not yet addressed.
 - Could use a task force.
 - o Social work care not yet addressed.
 - Could be tied together with respite care task force.
 - Social work education.
 - First step could be observation of adult hospice.
